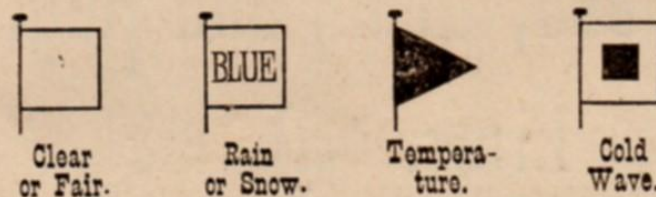

### INTERPRETATION OF SIGNALS.

White flag, clear or fair weather, no rain. Blue flag, rain or snow. Black triangular flag, refers to temperature, and above white flag, indicates warmer weather; below white flag, colder weather, and when not displayed, stationary weather. White flag with black center (cold-wave flag) sudden fall in temperature; this signal is usually ordered at least twenty-four hours in advance of the cold-wave. It is not displayed unless a temperature of forty-five degrees, or less, is expected, nor is the black triangular flag ever displayed with it.
